As you may know, Meadowbrook was accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (and Middle States Association) in December of 2013. This year our school is up for re-accreditation, with a visiting team scheduled to be on campus October 4-7. This is in conjunction with an extensive self-study that was completed this past year by the school. This team of five leaders from other Christian schools will be visiting classrooms, observing procedures, and meeting with staff/faculty, school board, parents, and students during these days. The end result will be reaccreditation for another seven years, as well as several recommendations for us as school moving forward that will be incorporated into our long-term strategic plan.

PSAT: The Preliminary SAT, also known as the PSAT/NMSQT® is a practice version of the SAT exam. (The SAT is an entrance exam used by most colleges and universities to make admissions decisions.) The purpose of the SAT is to measure a high school student's readiness for college, and provide colleges with one common data point that can be used to compare all applicants. The PSAT is 2 hours and 45 minutes long and tests students' skills in reading, writing, and math. Results from the PSAT can identify areas where students may need to improve in preparing for their SAT exam.
