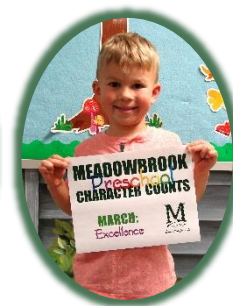

REMINDERS & UPDATES

FINANCIAL AID DEADLINE APPROACHING! To apply for financial aid for the 2021-2022 school year, please make sure you have completed **both steps** in the two-step application process **by May 15, 2021**. The explanation letter and MCSSO application are attached to today's MCS News email for your convenience. Financial aid offers will be sent in June and will be reflected on your FACTS tuition payment plan before the first payment of 2021-22 is due.

Meadowbrook's 4th grade science students are learning about the earth's resources and how to be good stewards of God's creation. Students collected their trash for one day to get an idea of how much waste they produce in just 24 hours. The students sorted their trash and recorded how much of each category they would have thrown away in a random day. After recording their observations, they were taught about recycling and encouraged to also think creatively about how some of their items might be able to be reused or how they might be able to reduce the amount of waste produced in the first place. These are all great ways to decrease the amount of trash that goes into our landfills and helps our students become good citizens in their communities and of the earth God created.
