APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID AT MEADOWBROOK IS A TWO-PART PROCESS:

PART 1: Complete the MCSSO Funding Application (free)

PART 2: Complete a Needs Assessment in FACTS (fee required)

Both parts are required to be considered for assistance.

Parents are responsible to make sure all applications and documents are submitted.

The process for reviewing financial aid applications once all documents have been submitted takes time and funds are limited. If you will be applying for financial aid, we strongly encourage you to submit your applications and documents when you enroll. If you are waiting on tax documents, begin the application process, submit documents as they are available, *and communicate your situation to the finance office*. **Financial aid is awarded for one year only and must be applied for annually. Previous awards are not a guarantee of a financial aid award or amount for an upcoming school year.**

FINANCIAL AID TIMELINE:

- **MARCH 1:** MCSSO & FACTS begin accepting applications for the upcoming school year
- **MAY 15: Deadline for Applications*:** All returning MCS families and new families enrolled before May 15 are required to have both the MCSSO and FACTS applications completed by May 15 to receive full consideration unless arrangements have been made with the school finance office. **Late applications submitted after May 15 will be subject to a 2% award reduction per week late.**
**New families enrolling after May 15 must submit applications within 72 hours to receive full consideration.*
- **JUNE 15: Financial Aid Notification:** Tuition assistance offers emailed to families with completed applications.
Please be sure to check your email and respond!
- **JUNE 30:** Deadline for families to accept or decline award offers. **Note:** Late responses may result in credits not being added to tuition accounts before July payment deadlines.

Nursery School (NS)

Nursery School is provided for children who are potty-trained and will be at least three years old on or before September 30th of the upcoming school year. Nursery School meets three days a week, on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, for two hours each day. Morning and afternoon sessions are available. Morning NS is from 9:15 AM to 11:15 AM, and afternoon NS is from 12:15 PM to 2:15 PM. Nursery School's goal is to introduce skills and to observe sufficient progress in all areas, including Bible, Reading and Writing Readiness, Numbers and Social Skills.

Junior Kindergarten (JRK)

Junior Kindergarten is provided for children who will be at least four years old on or before September 30th of the upcoming school year. Junior Kindergarten has morning and afternoon sessions available. Junior Kindergarten classes meet five days a week for three hours each day. Morning JRK is from 8 AM to 11 AM, and afternoon JRK is from 11:45 AM to 2:45 PM. Junior Kindergarten consists of learning the Bible, Phonics, Handwriting, and Numbers.

Kindergarten (KDG)

Kindergarten is provided for children who will be at least five years old on or before September 30th of the upcoming school year. Kindergarten is also a five-day-a-week program, meeting three hours each day, either morning or afternoon. Morning KDG is from 8 AM to 11 AM, and afternoon KDG is from 11:45 AM to 2:45 PM. Kindergarten class consists of learning the Bible, Phonics and Reading Groups, Handwriting, Numbers, Social Studies and Science.

Daycare

Meadowbrook Daycare is available to families with students enrolled in Nursery School, Junior Kindergarten, or Kindergarten at Meadowbrook Christian School.

ELEMENTARY:

Elementary classrooms are self-contained settings with highly qualified Christian teachers. The subjects taught in these grades include Bible, Reading, Spelling, English, Math, Science, History, and utilize a mix of A Beka, Purposeful Design (ACSI), and Bob Jones texts. Additionally, each grade has specials in Art, Music, Introductory Spanish, Keyboarding (4th-5th grades), Library, and Physical Education.

MIDDLE SCHOOL:

Meadowbrook offers a Middle School for grades 6th, 7th, and 8th. Students rotate among middle school teachers as they move from subject to subject. Placement for Math courses begin at the end of 5th grade allowing for students to be given the opportunity to take courses best suited for their individual strengths. These courses include Pre-Algebra, Algebra and Algebra 2. Students take courses in Science, Social Studies, Math, and Bible each year.

In addition, courses such as Learning Enrichment Across Disciplines (L.E.A.D.), Art, Music, Computers, Spanish, Communications are also offered. Students are given the opportunity to participate in musicals, fine arts competitions, spelling bee, and various leadership opportunities. Students are also able to participate in Junior High soccer, basketball, wrestling, and track. Individualized piano and voice lessons are also available.

HIGH SCHOOL:

In addition to the core courses listed below students may elect to take Art, Chorus, Speed and Agility, Yearbook, Office Support, Introductory to Education, Spanish 3, Spanish 4, and Computer Programming and Coding. New electives are being added. Juniors and Seniors can also elect to take Honors classes in Bible, English, Spanish, Science, History, and AP Calculus. In addition, there is a dual enrollment program made available to high achieving juniors and seniors to have the opportunity to enroll in dual credit courses.

Students can participate in Student Government, Key Club, and National Honor Society. Every 11th grade class goes on a Mission Trip, which usually involves traveling to Central or South America, completing building projects, as well as leading a VBS program with a local church. Fundraising begins in 6th grade leading to monthly fundraisers in 11th grade.

Additional opportunities are given to students through our Dimensions Program. This program is designed to give students unique opportunities not typically offered in core class offerings. The Dimensions Program exists to both equip students with life and career skills that will benefit them in the future, and to engage quality community professionals with our student body. Sample offerings include classes in Worship Arts Technology, Praise and Worship Team, CPR and First Aid, SAT Prep and Speed and Agility. New Programs are being added each semester that are tailored to the needs of our students.

MCS has become well-known for its quality Broadway productions such as Annie, Fiddler on the Roof, The Sound of Music, Wizard of Oz, and many others.

The soccer, basketball, wrestling, and track teams participate in both the ACAA and the PIAA, allowing for participation with both Christian and public schools, and students have further sports opportunities through our cooperative agreement with the Milton School District. These sports include Baseball, Bowling, Cross Country, Field Hockey, Football, Golf, Marching Band, Softball, and Tennis.
